Why MBBS in Mauritius?

Curriculum

Syllabus is as per University broadly based on TEC Guidelines, framed suitable to train the candidate to be competent for any qualifying tests of developed countries viz. INDIA, USA, UK, SOUTH AFRICA, etc.

The course is of 5 years duration, in phased manner (I, II & III) divided into 10 Semesters of 6 Months each.

Internship

The course of five years will be followed by a compulsory rotating Internship. The foreign students shall do their internship in their respective country of origin on their own.

Requirements

Academic

The candidates must have passed Intermediate of Science / Class XII / 10+2 / A-levels / PUC / any equivalent systems at one sitting, any 3 subjects preferably in science with a minimum of 21 points (HSC/Cambridge system) or an aggregate of minimum 60%.

Minimum Age

The applicant must have completed 17 years of age on or before 31st Dec of the academic year in which the candidate is seeking admission.

Mauritius

Mauritius is situated in the south-west Indian Ocean, A little above the tropic of Capricorn with a latitude of 20° south and a longitude of 57° east of Greenwich. It is 2,000 km off the east coast of Africa and some 855 km east of Madagascar.

An island of volcanic origin with an area of 1,864 square kilometer, it is almost entirely surrounded by coral reefs. Enjoyable and beautiful though, Mauritius is also a safe place to live either as a national, professional, student or family. Crime prevalence is very low making Mauritius one of the safest law-abiding countries of the world.

Time

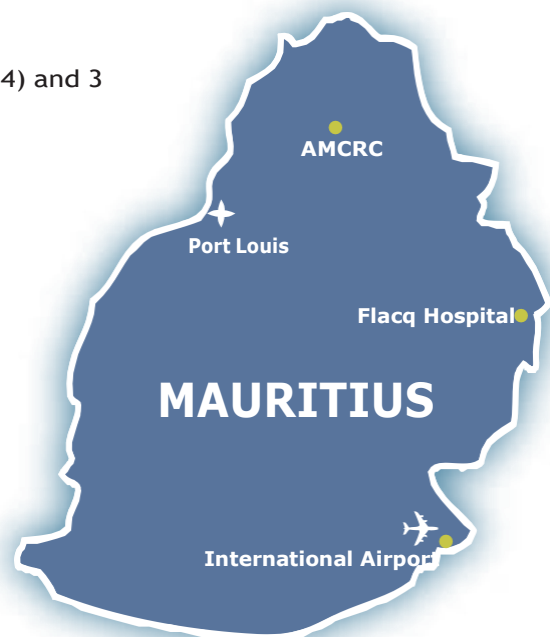
Mauritius is 4 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT +4) and 3 hours ahead of mid-European time.

Currency

The monetary unit is the Mauritian Rupee (Rs.) which is divided into 100 cents (cs). Coins exist as 50-cents, 1-rupee, 5-rupees, 10-rupees and 20-rupees. Notes exist in the following denominations: Rs 25, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1000 and 2000. There are no exchange controls in Mauritius.

International Airport

The Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport, also known as Plaisance (code: MRU) is approximately 48 kms from the capital city, Port Louis. Facilities include VIP lounges, duty-free shops both on arrival and departure, restaurants, banks and a Post Office.





Cultural Diversity

Mauritius is well known for its cultural diversity. Here, various traditions flourish in peace and is reputed as a nation of racial harmony.

Economic and Political Stability

It has preserved its image as one of Africa's few social and economic success stories. Mauritius has the highest adult literacy rate for the whole of Africa. Its political stability has helped Mauritius become one of Africa's most prosperous economies. The currency is the Mauritian rupee.

Safe for living

Both expatriates and citizens are in agreement that this enchanting island is a safe place for everyone. On the health front, the country is free from many of the diseases affecting the sub-tropical countries of the world.
